










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Introduction

At the beginning of the project "My Europe – your Europe – your say" – ME-YOU-US (Erasmus+ - Key Action 2: Strategic Partnerships in School Education), a Dissemination Plan Strategy has been set up, in order to distribute general information about the project first; and then to give visibility to the ME-YOU-US outputs, publications and meetings, to make them accessible to as wide an audience as possible.

By using the template created by ALTIUS foundation, all the partners have listed the collected dissemination activity, describing the type, duration, outreach, target group's characteristics and approximate number of the people reached and attaching at the end the linked evidence.

Each partner has been in charge of the development a national dissemination report including all the dissemination actions done, divided per type according to the abovementioned structure and specific categories.

The monitoring procedures and especially the templates for planning and reporting the dissemination activities helped to keep track of the partners' dissemination efforts. This document aims to present the dissemination activities undertaken within the partnership, and it intends to outline how the dissemination process has been carried out in the lifetime of the project, on the basis of what has been stated in the Dissemination Plan Strategy.

A summary of the templates that partners filled in four separate occasions to report their dissemination activities are displayed below in the document, in order to provide a detailed overview of the various national dissemination reports collected by the partners at a local, regional, national and international level, under the monitoring and coordination action of ALTIUS foundation. The templates will be followed by a final table containing the overall results of all the national disseminations during the project.

At the end, conclusions are drawn, allowing to show an overview of the dissemination action of these three years of cooperation.









Dissemination strategy

The Dissemination Strategy defined at the beginning of the project has established that all the partners are responsible for national dissemination at a local, regional and national level, under the monitoring action of ALTIUS.

Each partner was expected therefore to disseminate general information about the ME-YOU-US project, its steps and results to a defined target group, characterized by teachers, students aged 12-15, local communities, and all the interested stakeholders.

The strategy has foreseen common directions and timelines to be followed by partners. The dissemination activities had to be aimed at reaching the widest target public through different types of activities planned in advance, which include:

- Internet based activities (website, Facebook, project and partners' newsletters, posts on partner's websites, etc...);

- Media based activities (Dissemination through media, newspapers, TV and radio, etc...);

- Face to Face activities (dissemination events or conferences, Local Multiplier Events, Final Conference, etc...);

- **Outputs/Publications/Products** (deliverables that will be published and/or printed, such as project reports, intellectual outputs, etc...).

The lead partner of the dissemination plan strategy has then shaped a template for the collection of dissemination data, to be filled by each partner. It includes guidelines which offer a short overview of the type of activity run, of the related period and of its outreach. The results obtained have then been collected by ALTIUS.

Common dissemination activities Project logo development

In order to provide the project with a good graphical representation that could effectively convey its message, the partners have agreed on the ME-YOU-US logo.

The logo proposals were presented to the partnership after the Kick-off Meeting, and the selected ones were the following:



On the homepage, the visitor can get an overview of the project's objectives, main actions and latest news. *Top section*









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
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



Google Analytics data report

Google analytics was activated in December 2019. The project website was one of the main means of dissemination of project results. It was the place where all training resources were uploaded and the participating teachers used it when organizing the training sessions with their students in order to get access to the lesson plans and the e-resources.

2020-2021

In the year 2020, the estimated monthly average of visitors is 135 sessions, corresponding to 607 page views. Both the number of sessions and the number of viewed pages show an upward trend.



During the school year 2019/2020, the month of January and February were the months with most sessions as this is the time before the lockdown when teachers used the training resources of the ME-YOU-US manual actively with their students. Later in March, 2020 most schools switched to distant learning with some difficulties in organizing the process at the beginning. We can identify more traffic in May and June 2020 when schools were already used to distant learning, and teachers resumed the trainings.


The new school year 2020/2021 started with an in-presence training process and the number of sessions per month is rather high.

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Later in the school year, there were some disruptions in the in-presence teaching and learning process in most of the countries. There is a positive trend in the last two months of the schools year (May, June) when students returned in the classrooms. Even in the summer months we can see more traffic compared to the previous year which might be due to the dissemination events in the partner countries and the campaigns we have organized for spreading the news about the training resources and the project in general.

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

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Instituto Politecnico de Santarém, Portugal

The Politechnic Institute of Santarém requested and received approval from the Continuing Education Scientific-Pedagogical Council for the delivery of the continuing teacher education course, reference number CCPFC/ACC-106169/19 based on the Teacher's Manual created in the project. Training courses included face-to-face training, during which teachers are taught how to use the Teacher's Manual, the available digital resources and a practical part (2-month distance learning), during which they were obliged to deliver training to students with the resources of the Manual, provide feedback and report the results. When they completed all tasks, they received a certificate for 30 hours of accredited training. IPSantarem delivered 2 training courses in 2020 with the registered trainees in partnership with the Center Educatis - Schools Training Center of the counties of Benavente, Coruche and Salvaterra de Magos. IPSantarém also organized 2 training courses in 2019/20 in cooperation with the training center of Leziria do Tejo - Association of Almeirim, Alpiarça and Santarém municipalities.

Conclusions
